Quilt size: 52" - Block size: 14 $\frac{3}{8}$ "

Yardage

CSGA 591 G (cats on green) - $\frac{3}{8}$ yard for basket blocks

CSGA 592 B (tossed cats on blue) - $\frac{7}{8}$ yard for setting triangles

CSGA 592 YG (tossed cats on yellow) - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard for setting blocks

CSGA 593 K (bugs on black) - $\frac{5}{8}$ yard for basket blocks and sashing squares

CSGA 593 B (bugs on dk. blue) - $\frac{1}{2}$ yard for binding

CSGA 593 LB (bugs on lt. blue) - $\frac{3}{4}$ yard for basket blocks

CSGA 594 G (blue/green stripe) - 1 yard for sashing

SFIE* 790 C (purple pindots) - $\frac{1}{3}$ yard for basket blocks and setting blocks

SFIE* 790 B (blue pindots) - $\frac{3}{4}$ yard for basket blocks and setting blocks

*Sunflower Fiesta fabric collection

Cutting

Cut all strips across the width of fabric (wof), selvage to selvage.

Cats on green, cut:

- (2) 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares; cut in half diagonally to yield (4) triangles

Blue pindots, cut:

- (2) 4" x wof strips; crosscut into (32) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4" rectangles
- (2) 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares; cut in half diagonally to yield (4) triangles
- (4) 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " squares; cut in half diagonally to yield (8) triangles

Bugs on lt. blue, cut:

- (8) 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{8}$ " rectangles
- (12) 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " squares; cut in half diagonally to yield (24) triangles
- (2) 6 $\frac{3}{8}$ " squares; cut in half diagonally to yield (4) triangles

Bugs on black, cut:

- (12) 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " squares; cut in half diagonally to yield (24) triangles
- (1) 6 $\frac{3}{8}$ " square; cut diagonally into quarters to yield (4) sashing triangles
- (5) 4" sashing squares
- (2) 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " squares; cut in half diagonally to yield (4) corner triangles

Purple pindots, cut:

- (2) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x wof strips; crosscut into (32) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares
- (4) 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " squares

Blue/green stripe, cut:

- (7) 4" strips; crosscut into (14) 4" x 14 $\frac{7}{8}$ " sashing strips

Cats on blue, cut:

- (4) 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares; cut diagonally into quarters to yield (16) setting triangles

Cats on yellow, cut:

- (8) 4" squares

Bugs on dk. blue, cut:

- (6) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x wof binding strips

Making the Basket Blocks

1. Sew a 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " blue pindot triangle and a 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " cats-on-green triangle together to make a half-square-triangle unit. Make a total of (4) large-triangle units.

2. Sew a 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " bugs-on-black triangle and a 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " bugs-on-lt.-blue triangle together to make a half-square-triangle unit. Make a total of (24) small-triangle units.

3. Sew 3 small-triangle units together as shown in figure 1 to make a triangle unit. Make a total of (4) triangle units and (4) reverse-triangle units.

4. Sew a 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " blue pindot triangle to one end of a 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{8}$ " bugs-on-lt.-blue rectangle to make a side unit as shown in figure 2. Make a total of (4) side units and (4) reverse-side units.

5. Lay out (1) large-triangle unit, (1) triangle unit, (1) reverse-triangle unit, and (1) 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " purple pindot square. Sew the pieces together in rows and then sew the rows together. (figure 1)

6. Sew a side unit and a reverse-side unit to the unit from step 5. Sew a 6 $\frac{5}{8}$ " bugs-on-lt.-blue triangle to the base of the basket. (figure 2)

7. Repeat steps 5 and 6 to make a total of (4) basket blocks.

Finishing the Quilt

10. Lay out the basket blocks, 4" x 14 $\frac{7}{8}$ " sashing strips, and 4" bugs-on-black squares. Add the setting triangles, (4) 6 $\frac{5}{8}$ " bugs-on-black triangles, and the (4) 3 $\frac{3}{8}$ " bugs-on-black corner triangles as shown in the layout diagram.

11. Sew the pieces together in diagonal rows and press the seam allowances toward the sashing strips. Sew the rows together, pressing the seam allowances toward the sashing rows. Square up the edges of the quilt top to 52" x 52".

12. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired. Bind the edges to finish. Add a label to the back of your quilt.

Making the Setting Triangles

8. Lay out (4) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " purple pindot squares, (4) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4" blue pindot squares, and (1) 4" cats-on-yellow square in a nine-patch arrangement. Sew the pieces together in rows and then sew the rows together. Make a total of (8) setting blocks. (figure 3)

9. Sew cats-on-blue triangles to adjacent sides of each setting block from step 8 to make large-setting triangles as shown in figure 3. Make a total of (8) triangles.
