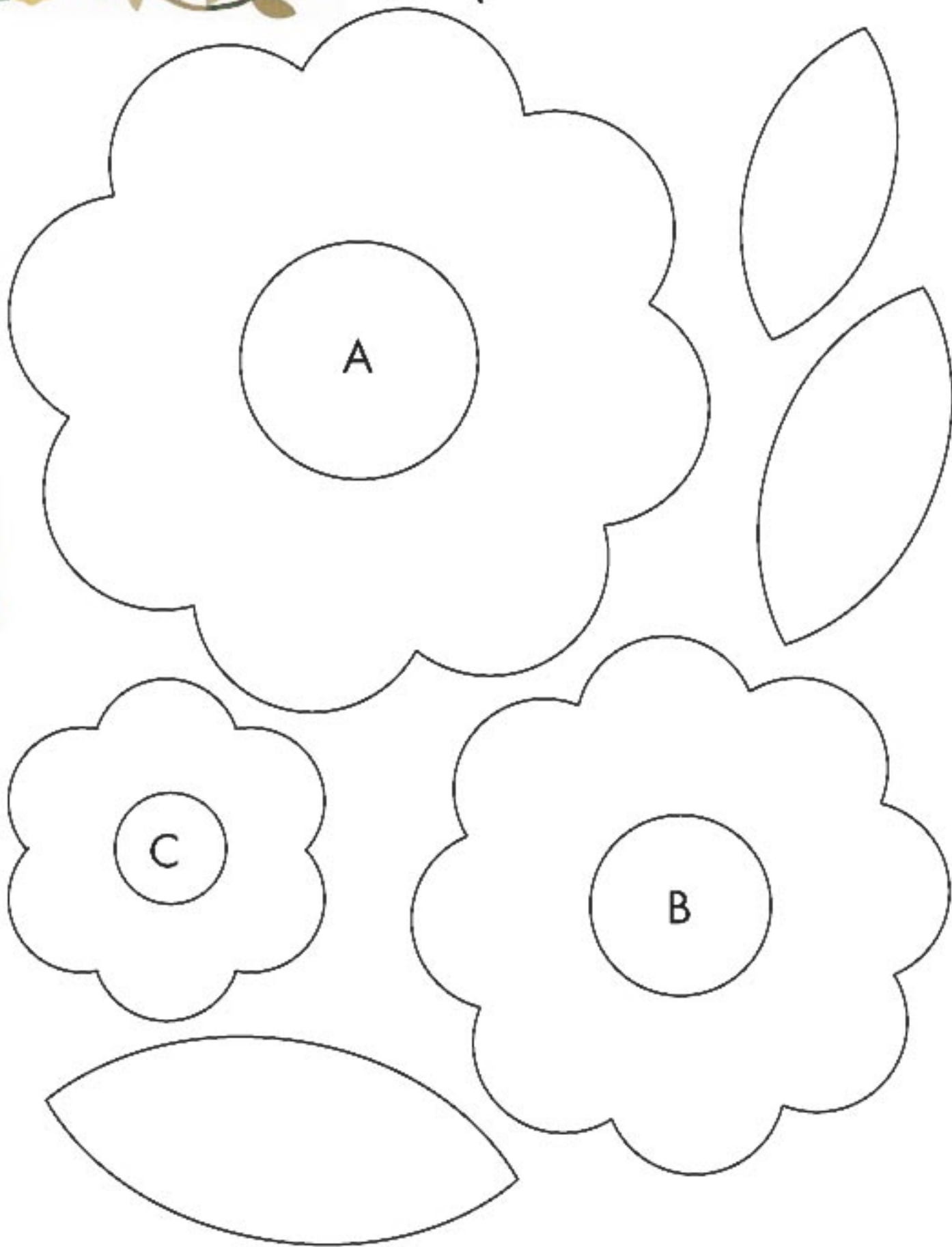
Spectral Delight quilt by Cyndi Hershey

Quilt by Cyndi Hershey using P&B Textile's *Color Spectrum* fabrics.

Finished Quilt Size: 74" square • Finished Block Size: 18"

• Yardage • • •

Yardage is based on 42"-wide fabric.

Black for background and borders:
5¹/₂ yards = CSPE K

Assorted dark colors for blocks and border appliqué flowers: fat quarter of *each* fabric:
CSPE R, BG, V, O, Y, BV, RV, G, B

Assorted light colors for centers of blocks and centers of border appliqué flowers:
fat eighth of *each* fabric = CSPE 01R, 02BG, 33V, 30O, 01Y, 02BV, 03RV, 01G, 02B

Lightest green for appliqué leaves:
¹/₈ yard = CSPE 11YG

Medium and dark green for appliqué vine and leaves:
¹/₂ yard *each* = CSPE 12YG and 13YG

Binding: ³/₄ yard of any *Color Spectrum* fabric (photo quilt uses black CSPE K)

Backing: 5¹/₂ yards of any *Color Spectrum* fabric

NOTE: All fabric is cut across the width of the fabric unless indicated otherwise.

• Cutting • • •

From the black fabric, cut:

5 strips, 3" x 42"; crosscut into 54 squares, 3" x 3". Cut each square once diagonally to yield 108 half-square triangles.

2 strips, 4¹/₄" x 42"; crosscut into 18 squares, 4¹/₄" x 4¹/₄". Cut each square diagonally in both directions to yield 72 quarter-square triangles.

2 strips, 7¹/₄" x 42"; crosscut into 9 squares, 7¹/₄" x 7¹/₄". Cut each square diagonally in both directions to yield 36 quarter-square triangles.

3 strips, 2¹/₂" x 42"; crosscut into 36 squares, 2¹/₂" x 2¹/₂"

6 strips, 6¹/₂" x 42"; crosscut into 36 squares 6¹/₂" x 6¹/₂"

6 strips, 2¹/₂" x 42"; crosscut into 12 rectangles, 2¹/₂" x 18¹/₂". Use remainder of strips to cut 4 squares, 2¹/₂" x 2¹/₂".

From the remaining length of the black fabric, cut:

4 strips, 8¹/₂" wide; cut two to 58¹/₂" in length and two to 74¹/₂" in length

From each of the dark color block fabrics, cut:

4 squares, 4¹/₄" x 4¹/₄"; cut each square diagonally in both directions to yield 16 quarter-square triangles

6 squares, 3" x 3"; cut each square once diagonally to yield 12 half-square triangles

From each of the light color block fabrics, cut:

5 squares, 2¹/₂" x 2¹/₂"

From both the medium and dark green fabrics, cut:

2 strips, 6" x 42"

From binding fabric, cut:

8 strips, 2¹/₂" x 42"

From appliqué fabrics, cut:

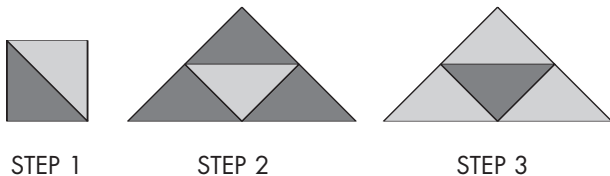
(Refer to photo as a guide. Templates *do not* include seam allowance. Cut shapes using your preferred method of appliqué.)

- Assorted number, sizes, and colors of flowers for border using remainder of dark color block fabrics
- Corresponding number, sizes and colors of flower centers using remainder of light color block fabrics
- Assorted number and sizes of leaves using all three green fabrics

• Construction • • •

FOR ONE BLOCK:

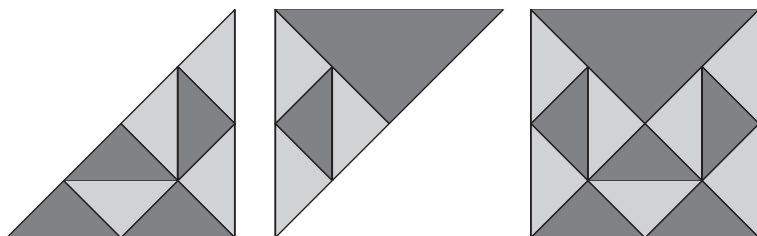
1. Sew a black 3" half-square triangle to a dark color 3" half-square triangle. Press seams toward the black triangles. Repeat to make 12 half-square units as shown below.
2. Sew a black 4¹/₄" quarter-square triangle to both sides of *four* units from Step 1 as shown. Press seams toward the black triangles.
3. Sew a dark color 4¹/₄" quarter-square triangle to both sides of the remaining units from Step 1 as shown. Press seams toward the dark color triangles. Make eight units.
4. Sew and press a unit from Step 2 to a unit from Step 3 as shown. Make four units.
5. Sew and press a unit from Step 3 to a black 7¹/₄" quarter-square triangle as shown. Make four units.
6. Sew and press a unit from Step 4 to a unit from Step 5. Make four units.
7. Sew the four 2¹/₂" black squares with five 2¹/₂" light color squares into a nine-patch unit as shown. Press seams toward the black squares.
8. Sew together and press four units from Step 6, a nine-patch unit from Step 7, and four black 6¹/₂" squares.
9. Repeat Steps 1 – 8 using each set of block fabrics, to make a total of nine blocks.

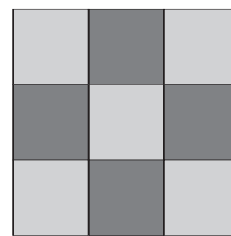

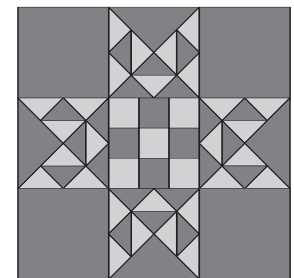

TO COMPLETE QUILT:

1. Arrange blocks into three rows with three blocks in each row. Sew a 2¹/₂" x 18¹/₂" black rectangle between each block in each horizontal row. Press seams toward the black rectangles.
2. Sew three black 2¹/₂" x 18¹/₂" rectangles with two black 2¹/₂" squares to create a black sashing row. Press seams toward the black rectangles. Repeat to make two sashing rows.
3. Sew a sashing row from Step 2 between each of the block rows from Step 1. Press seams toward the sashing rows.
4. Sew an 8¹/₂" x 58¹/₂" border to opposite sides of the quilt center. Press seams toward the borders. Sew an 8¹/₂" x 74¹/₂" border to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press seams toward the borders.
5. Sew the medium and dark green 6" strips together alternating colors to create a strip set. Press seams *open*. Cut one end of the strip set at a 45 degree angle. Use the new angled edge to align ruler and cut six strips, 1¹/₂" wide. Sew these strips together, continuing color placement pattern. Press seams open. Use your favorite method to create tubes/stems. Refer to photo to position the stems on your quilt as desired. You will have plenty of the strip set remaining if you'd like to make the stems longer on your quilt. Appliqué stems to quilt using your preferred machine or hand appliqué technique.
6. Position flowers, centers and leaves along stems. Appliqué these pieces to quilt using your preferred machine or hand appliqué technique.
7. Layer, baste, and quilt as desired. You will notice that the large black areas provide a wonderful opportunity to display some creative quilting.
8. Make binding and sew to the quilt. Attach your quilt label and you're finished!
