# DOWN ON THE FARM

Quilt by Susan Schwarting using the *Farm Out!* fabric collection by P&B Textiles  
Size: 67" x 85"

## YARDAGE

FARM 393 YG (main print)	1 3/4 yards
FARM 394 YG (neutral stripe)	2 1/2 yards
FARM 395 YG (neutral patchwork)	2 1/8 yards
FARM 396 Y (bright chickens)	5/8 yard
FARM 396 Z (neutral chickens)	1/4 yard
FARM 398 E (ecru vines)	1 5/8 yards
FARM 398 G (green vines)	5/8 yard
FARM 398 I (orange vines)	5/8 yard
FARM 399 Y (yellow swirls)	1 yard
FARM 399 Z (brown swirls)	1/2 yard

Backing: 5 1/4 yards of any *Farm Out!* fabric

## DIAMOND IN THE SQUARE BLOCK



### CUTTING

All strips are cut across the width of fabric (wof).

**Main Print (393 YG), fussy-cut:**

- (13) 10 3/4" squares

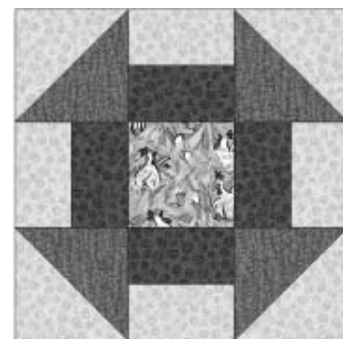
**Ecru Vine (398 E), cut:**

- (9) 5 5/8" x wof strips; crosscut into (52) 5 5/8" squares

## ASSEMBLY

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each ecru vine square. On 26 ecru squares draw the line from the upper-left corner to the lower-right corner. On the remaining ecru squares draw the line from the lower-left corner to the upper-right corner. Place a marked square on opposite corners of the main print square, right sides together and making sure the vines are oriented in the same direction. Sew along the line. Trim the excess corner fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance and press the resulting triangle open. In the same manner, sew marked squares to the two remaining corners, again making sure the vines in all of the triangles are going in the same direction. The block should measure 10 3/4" square. Make 13 blocks.

## HOLE IN THE BARN DOOR BLOCK



### CUTTING

All strips are cut across the width of fabric (wof).

**Yellow swirls (399 Y), cut:**

- (5) 2 1/4" x wof strips
- (3) 4 3/8" x wof strips; crosscut into (24) 4 3/8" squares, then cut each square in half diagonally to yield (48) triangles
- (16) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles
- (8) 2 7/8" squares; cut each square in half diagonally to yield (16) triangles

### **Brown swirls (399 Z), cut:**

- (5) 2 1/4" x wof strips
- (16) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

### **Orange vines (398 I), cut:**

- (3) 4 3/8" x wof strips; with the strips folded wrong sides together, crosscut (24) 4 3/8" squares, then cut the pair of squares in half diagonally to yield (48) triangles
- (1) 2 7/8" x wof strip; with the strip folded wrong sides together, crosscut (8) 2 7/8" squares, then cut the pair of squares in half diagonally to yield (16) triangles

### **Neutral chickens (396 Z), cut:**

- (12) 3 3/4" squares
- (4) 2 1/2" squares

## **LARGE BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

Join each brown strip to a yellow strip to make a strip set and press the seam allowances toward the brown strip. Make five strip sets and crosscut then into (48) 3 3/4"-wide segments.

Join the 4 3/8" yellow triangles and orange triangles to make (48) half-square-triangle units.

Lay out four half square triangle units, four yellow/brown segments, and one 3 3/4" chicken square in a nine-patch arrangement. Make sure the vine in all of the orange triangles is going in the same direction. Join the pieces into rows and then join the rows to make a block. The block should measure 10 3/4" square. Make 12 blocks.

## **CORNER BLOCK ASSEMBLY**

Join each brown rectangle to a yellow rectangle to make a side unit. Press the seam allowances toward the brown rectangle. Make 16 units.

Join the 2 7/8" yellow triangles and orange triangles to make (16) half-square-triangle units.

Lay out four half square triangle units, four yellow/brown side units, and one 2 1/2" chicken square in a nine-patch arrangement. Make sure the vine in all of the orange triangles is going in the same direction. Join the pieces into rows and then join the rows to make a block. The block should measure 6 1/2" square. Make 4 corner blocks.

# **CHECKERBOARD STRIPS**

## **CUTTING**

*All strips are cut across the width of fabric (wof).*

### **Bright chickens (396 Y), cut:**

- (5) 3 1/2" x wof strips; crosscut into (54) 3 1/2" squares

### **Green vines (398 G), cut:**

- (5) 3 1/2" x wof strips; crosscut into (48) 3 1/2" squares

## **ASSEMBLY**

Beginning and ending with chicken square; join 9 chicken squares and 8 green vine squares to make a strip, make sure to orient the vine in all of the squares in the same direction. Make 6 strips.

# **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

## **CUTTING**

### **Neutral patchwork (395 YG), cut:**

- (2) 2 1/2" x 72" lengthwise border strips
- (2) 2 1/2" x 60" lengthwise border strips
- (5) 2 1/2" x 64" lengthwise binding strips

### **Neutral stripe (394 YG), cut:**

- (2) 6 1/2" x 77" lengthwise strips; centering the same motif in the middle of each strip
- (2) 6 1/2" x 60" lengthwise strips; centering the same motif in the middle of each strip

## **ASSEMBLY**

Referring to quilt photo, join the block rows and checkerboard strips, alternating them as shown and easing the rows to fit as needed.

For the inner border; measure the length of the quilt top and trim the 72"-long neutral patchwork strips to this length. Sew the strips to opposite sides of the quilt top. Measure the width of the quilt top and trim the 60"-long neutral patchwork strips to this length. Sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

For the outer border; measure the length of the quilt top and trim the 77"-long strips to that measurement. Measure the width of the quilt top and trim the 60"-long strips to that measurement. Sew the longer strips to the sides of the quilt top. Sew 6 1/2" corner blocks to the ends of the shorter border strips and attach them to top and bottom edges of the quilt top.

Layer quilt with batting and backing; quilt as desired. Bind using the 2 1/2" neutral patchwork strips.
