Fabric Requirements

FBEL 253 P (Pink Buds)	1/3 yard
FBEL 253 Y (Yellow Buds)	1/3 yard
FBEL 254 FP (Pink Floral)	2/3 yard
FBEL 254 TP (Teal Floral)	1/3 yard
FBEL 254 WO (Orange Floral)	1/3 yard
FBEL 255 P (Pink Stripe)	1/3 yard
FBEL 256 P (Pink Dots)	1/3 yard
FBEL 257 C (Violet Flowers)	1/3 yard
FBEL 257 G (Aqua Flowers)	1/3 yard
FBEL 257 O (Orange Flowers)	1/3 yard
FBEL 257 P (Pink Flowers)	1/3 yard
FBEL 257 Y (Yellow Flowers)	1/3 yard
FBEL 257 YG (Lime Flowers)	1/3 yard
CSNE-W (White solid)	1 yard

Backing: 3 yards of any *Flora Bella* fabric

Cutting

All strips are cut across the width of fabric (wof).

From the Pink Floral, cut:

- (20) 2 1/2" squares (block centers)
- (6) 2 1/2" x wof binding strips

From the White solid, cut:

- (8) 2" x wof strips; crosscut into (31) 2" x 9 1/2" sashing strips
- (6) 2" x wof border strips

From each of the Pink Buds, Yellow Buds, Teal Floral, Orange Floral, Pink Stripe, and Pink Dots, cut:

- 1" to 2" x wof strips (vary the width of the strips, cutting them at a slight angle)*

From each of the Violet Flowers, Aqua Flowers, Orange Flowers, Pink Flowers, Yellow Flowers, and Lime Flowers, cut:

- (2) 2" sashing squares (12 total)
- 1" to 2" x wof strips (vary the width of the strips, cutting them at a slight angle)*

*Start by cutting 2 or 3 strips of each fabric and then cut more strips as needed.

Assembly Instructions

Mix up the 1" to 2"-wide strips to create a scrappy assortment.

1. Refer to the photo as needed. Sew an assorted strip to one side of a Pink Floral square and press.

2. Sew a different print strip to an adjacent side of the Pink Floral square and press. Continue adding strips in the same manner; pressing after each strip until the block measures 10 1/2". Trim the block to measure 9 1/2" square.

3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 to make 20 blocks, each measuring 9 1/2" square.

4. Starting and ending with a block, join four blocks and three 2" x 9 1/2" white sashing strips, alternating them to make a block row. Repeat to make a total of five block rows.

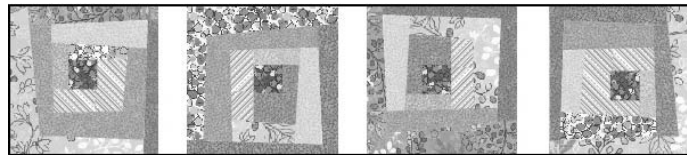
5. Starting and ending with a white sashing strip, join four white sashing strips and three assorted 2" sashing squares to make a sashing row. Repeat to make a total of four sashing rows.

6. Starting with a block row, join the block rows and sashing rows, alternating them to make the quilt top.

7. Join the 2"-wide white border strips end to end. From the long strip, cut two 51 1/2"-long strips and sew them to the sides of the quilt top. Cut two 44"-long strips and sew them to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

8. Layer the quilt with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired and bind the edges to finish.
