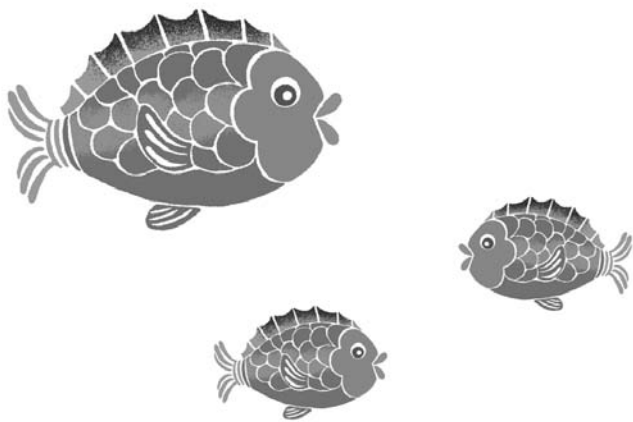

## Yardages

GSEA 164 B (Main Print)	3/4 yard
GSEA 165 BG (Blue Seaweed)	3/4 yard
GSEA 166 B (Blue Starfish)	1/4 yard
GSEA 166 Y (Yellow Starfish)	1 1/3 yards
GSEA 167 B (Blue Wave)	1/4 yard
GSEA 167 T (Teal Wave)	1/4 yard
GSEA 168 B (Blue Circles)	1/2 yard
GSEA 168 G (Green Circles)	1/2 yard
GSEA 169 B (Blue Bubbles)	3/4 yard
GSEA 169 T (Teal Bubbles)	1/3 yard

**Backing:** 3 1/4 yards of any *Gems of the Sea* fabric



## Cutting

All strips are cut across the width of fabric (wof).

### Yellow Starfish, cut:

- (4) 5 1/2" x wof strips; using template A, cut (48) A pieces and (48) A-reversed pieces
- (18) 4 3/8" squares; cut each square once diagonally to yield (36) triangles.
- (32) 2 5/8" squares; cut each square once diagonally to yield (64) triangles

### Blue Wave, cut:

- (5) 5 1/2" squares

### Teal Wave, cut:

- (4) 5 1/2" squares

### Green Circles, cut:

- (9) 6" squares; cut each square once diagonally to yield (18) triangles

### Blue Circles, cut:

- (9) 6" squares; cut each square once diagonally to yield (18) triangles

### Main Print, cut:

- (2) 10 1/2" x wof strips; using template B, cut (12) B pieces

### Blue Seaweed, cut:

- (2) 10 1/2" x wof strips; using template B, cut (12) B pieces

### Blue Starfish, cut:

- (16) 3" squares

### Blue Bubbles, cut:

- (16) 3 1/2" squares; cut each square once diagonally to yield (32) triangles
- (6) 2 1/2" x wof binding strips

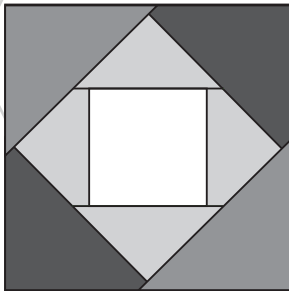
### Teal Bubbles:

- (16) 3 1/2" squares; cut each square once diagonally to yield (32) triangles

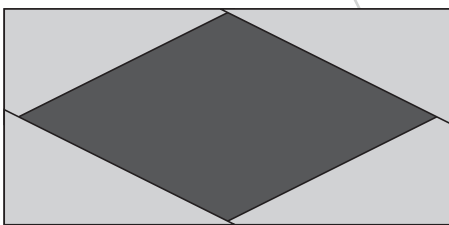
## Template A

### Assembly

1. Sew 4  $\frac{3}{8}$ " yellow starfish triangles to opposite sides of a blue wave square; press. Sew 4  $\frac{3}{8}$ " yellow starfish triangles to the two remaining sides of the blue wave square to make the center unit for block A. Trim the unit to measure 7  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make five block A units.
2. Repeat step 1 using the teal wave squares to make four center units for block B.
3. Sew green circles triangles to the upper-left and lower-right corners of each block A center unit; press. Sew blue circles triangles to the upper-right and lower-left corners of each block A center unit. Trim the blocks to measure 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make five of block A.
4. Sew blue circles triangles to the upper-left and lower-right corners of each block B center unit; press. Sew green circles triangles to the upper-right and lower-left corners of each block B center unit. Trim the blocks to measure 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make four of block B.



5. Sew yellow starfish A pieces to the upper-left and lower-right corners of a main print B piece; press. Sew yellow starfish A-reversed pieces to the upper-right and lower-left corners of the B piece. Repeat with the remaining A, A-reversed, and B pieces to make 12 main print sashing units and 12 seaweed sashing units. Trim the units to measure 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ ", as needed.

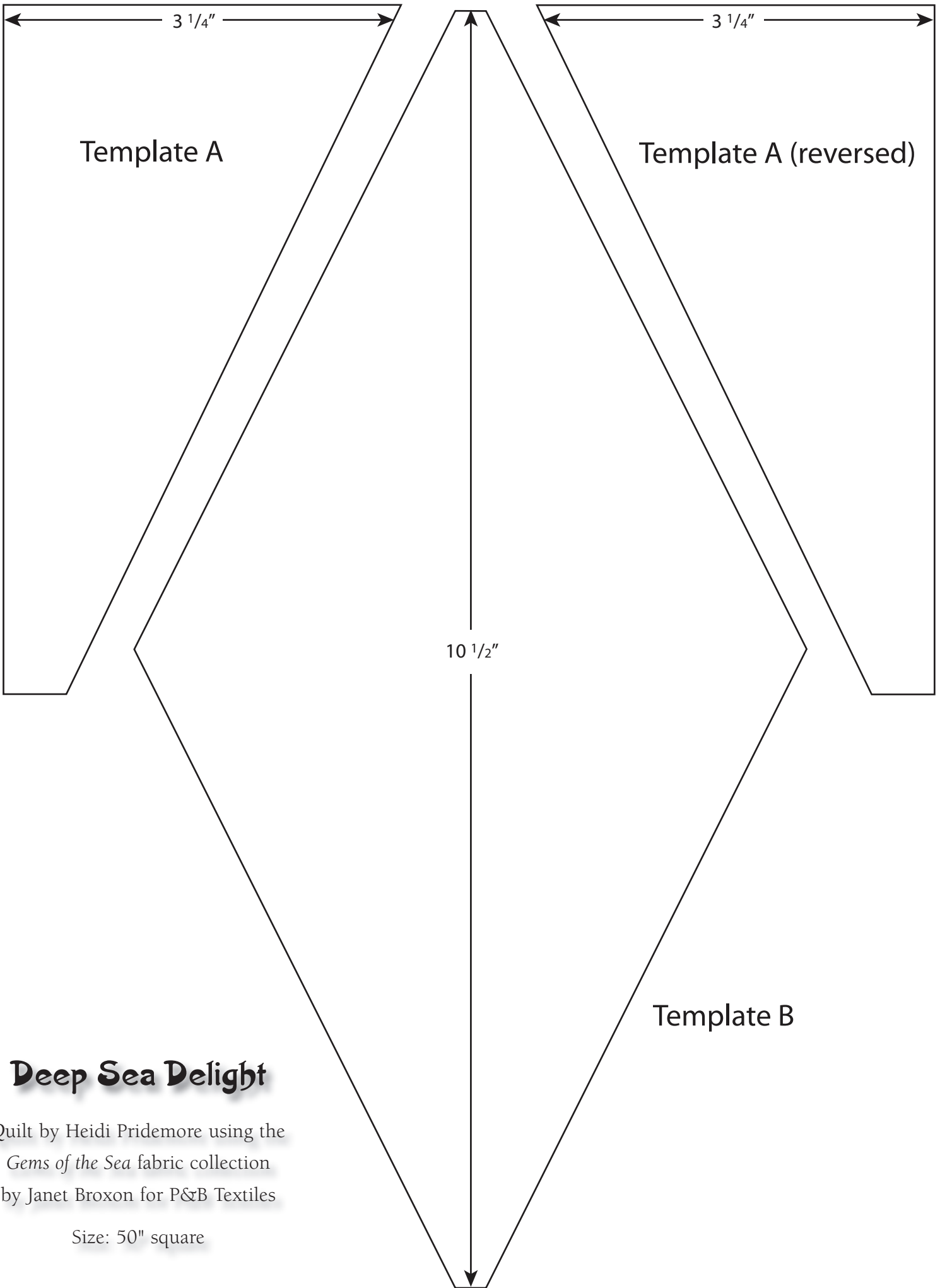


## Template A (reversed)

6. Sew 2  $\frac{5}{8}$ " yellow starfish triangles to opposite sides of a blue starfish square. Sew 2  $\frac{5}{8}$ " yellow starfish triangles to the two remaining sides of the blue starfish square to make a center unit. Sew blue bubbles triangles to the upper-left and lower-right corners of the center unit. Sew green bubbles triangles to the upper-right and lower-left corners of the square to complete a sashing corner. Repeat to make 16 sashing corners. Trim the sashing corners to measure 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square, as needed.
7. Refer to the photo for placement guidance. Join four sashing corners from step 6 and three sashing units from step 5, alternating them as shown in the photo to make a sashing row. Make four sashing rows.
8. Join three blocks and four sashing units, alternating them as shown in the photo to make a block row. Make three block rows.
9. Join the blocks rows and sashing rows, beginning and ending with a sashing row, to complete the quilt top.
10. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired and bind the edges to finish.
