This unique combination has brought Linderella's Quilt Design Studio national recognition and a loyal following of dedicated quilters, crafters and sewing enthusiasts looking for the "bright side" of quilting.

"I was bored with sewing squares to squares and perfecting my completely imperfect 1/4" seam.....I wanted to sew something that would keep my interest and would make me happy from start to finish.....I wanted to sew something that was fun and bright!"

In just three short years, Linda and her company now enjoy the reputation of being uniquely original, "graphically groovy" and best of all, fun and bright. Most of her patterns are humorous or playful in theme, depicting animated characters mixed with bright, bold graphic shapes. To date, the pattern line includes over twenty well-known and best-selling designs, such as "My Kingdom for a Toad", "Bat Magic" and "Feelin' Groovy" to name a few.

Several of Linda's other designs have been featured in nationally known publications such as "McCall's Quilting" and "McCall's Quick Quilts". Most recently, she designed her first line of "Fun and Bright" fabrics for P&B Textiles and has also authored a book of companion quilt designs to be published by Leisure Arts in Spring 2005.
