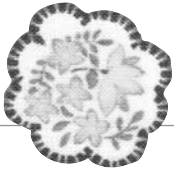


Sophie's Squares quilt by Diane Nagle

Quilt Size: 51" square • Block size: 8"

Yardage

SOPH 407BE (blue large floral):
3/8 yard for block A

SOPH 407BY (yellow/blue large floral):
3/8 yard for block A

SOPH 407PE (pink large floral):
3/8 yard for block B

SOPH 407PY (yellow/pink large floral):
3/8 yard for block A

SOPH 408B (blue paisley):
1/8 yard for block A

SOPH 408P (pink paisley):
1/8 yard for block A

SOPH 410G (green med. floral):
1/4 yard for block B

SOPH 410B (blue med. floral):
3/8 yard for block A

SOPH 410P (pink med. floral):
1/3 yard for blocks A and B

SOPH 411PE (white/red check):
1/8 yd for block A

SOPH 411BE (white/blue check):
1/8 yard for block A

SOPH 411G (green check):
1/4 yard for block B

SOPH 411P (red check):
1/4 yard for block B

SOPH 411B (blue check):
3/4 yard for block B and binding

SOPH 411Y (yellow check):
1/4 yard for block B

SOPH 412P (pink stripe):
1/2 yard of blocks A and B

SOPH 412B (blue stripe):
3/8 yard for outer border

Cutting

Cut all strips across the width of fabric (wof) from selvage to selvage.

SOPH 407BE (blue large floral), **SOPH 407BY** (yellow/blue large floral), and **SOPH 407PY** (yellow/pink large floral) - from *each* print, cut (2) 4 1/2" x wof strips; crosscut into (5) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles and (5) 4 1/2" squares

SOPH 410B (blue med. floral) - cut (1) 4 1/2" x wof strip; crosscut into (3) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles and (3) 4 1/2" squares. Cut (6) 3" squares.

SOPH 412P (pink stripe) - cut (4) 2" x wof strips; crosscut into (18) 2" x 4 1/2" rectangles and (18) 2" x 3" rectangles. Cut (3) 1 1/2" x wof strip; crosscut into (18) 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles and (18) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles.

SOPH 411BE (white/blue check) - cut (6) 3" squares

SOPH 411PE (white/red check) - cut (1) 3" squares

SOPH 408B (blue paisley) - cut (2) 3" squares

SOPH 408P (pink paisley) - cut (2) 3" squares

SOPH 410P (pink med. floral) - cut (4) 1 1/2" x wof strips; crosscut into (8) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (8) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips. Cut (1) 3" square.

SOPH 407PE (pink large floral) - cut (2) 6 1/2" x wof strips; crosscut into (18) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. Cut (2) 3 1/2" x wof strips, crosscut into (18) 3 1/2" squares.

SOPH 410G (green med. floral) - cut (2) 2 1/2" x wof strips; crosscut into (18) 2 1/2" squares

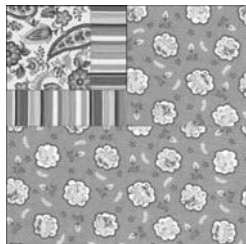
SOPH 411B (blue check) - cut (6) 2 1/2" x wof binding strips. Cut (5) 1 1/2" x wof strips; crosscut into (10) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (10) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips

SOPH 411Y (yellow check), **SOPH 411G** (green check), and **SOPH 411P** (red check) - from *each* print, cut (3) 1 1/2" x wof strips; crosscut into (6) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (6) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips

SOPH 412B (blue stripe) - cut (5) 2" x wof outer border strips

Construction

Block A



1. Sew a pink stripe 2" x 3" rectangle to each 3" square. With the pink stripe rectangle on the right hand side, sew a pink stripe 2" x 4¹/₂" rectangle to the bottom of each unit.

2. Join a large floral 4¹/₂" square to the pink stripe side of each unit and then join a matching large floral 4¹/₂" x 8¹/₂" rectangle to the bottom of each unit to complete the block. Make a total of 18 A blocks.

Block B



1. Sew a pink stripe 1¹/₂" x 2¹/₂" rectangle to each green check 2¹/₂" square. With the pink stripe rectangle on the left, sew a pink stripe 1¹/₂" x 3¹/₂" rectangle to the top of each unit.

2. Join a pink large floral 3¹/₂" square to the pink stripe side of each unit and then join a matching pink large floral 3¹/₂" x 6¹/₂" rectangle to the top of each unit.

3. Referring to the photo, sew matching 1¹/₂" x 6¹/₂" strips to opposite sides of a unit from Step 2 and then sew matching 1¹/₂" x 8¹/₂" strips to the remaining sides. In the same manner, sew matching strips of each colorway to the remaining units to make a total of 18 B blocks.

Quilt Assembly and Borders

1. Referring to the photo for color placement, lay out the A and B blocks in six rows of six blocks (3 A and 3 B blocks). Alternate the blocks in each row and from one row to the next. Rotate the A block in rows 2, 4, and 6 as shown in the photo.

2. Sew the blocks into rows and then sew the rows together.

3. Sew the 2"-wide outer-border strips together end to end. From this strip, cut (2) 48¹/₂"-long strips and (2) 51¹/₂"-long strips. Sew the shorter strips to the sides and the longer strips to top and bottom of quilt top.

4. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired. Using the 2¹/₂"-wide blue check strips, bind the edges to finish. Add a label to the back of your quilt and enjoy!
