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Using *Safari So Good* fabric collection by P&B Textiles

Quilt size: 64" x 75"

Yardage

SAFA 431 K (main print)	1 $\frac{5}{8}$ yards
SAFA 433 R (monkeys)	1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards
SAFA 434 Z (brown vines)	$\frac{7}{8}$ yard
SAFA 435 YO (yellow texture)	$\frac{5}{8}$ yard
SAFA 432 K (black with birds)	$\frac{3}{8}$ yard

Binding - $\frac{5}{8}$ yard of any SAFA fabric
Backing - 4 yards of any SAFA fabric

Cutting

Cut all strips across the width of fabric (wof).

SAFA 431 K

cut (1) piece 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for the quilt center

SAFA 433 R

cut (7) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof strips for the outer border

SAFA 434 Z

cut (6) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof strips for the middle border

SAFA 435 YO

cut (5) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x wof strips for the inner border

SAFA 432 K

cut (4) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, (4) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, and (4) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for corner squares

Binding

cut (8) 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x wof strips

Construction

1. Sew the 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide yellow (SAFA 435 YO) strips together end to end. From this strip, cut (2) 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ "-long strips and (2) 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ "-long strips. Sew the longer strips to the sides of the quilt top. Sew a 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " black (SAFA 432 K) square to both ends of each shorter strip and then sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

2. Sew the 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide brown vine (SAFA 434 Z) strips together end to end. From this strip, cut (2) 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ "-long strips and (2) 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ "-long strips. Sew the longer strips to the sides of the quilt top. Sew a 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " black (SAFA 432 K) square to both ends of each shorter strip and then sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

3. Sew the 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ "-wide monkey (SAFA 434 R) strips together end to end. From this strip, cut (2) 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ "-long strips and (2) 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ "-long strips. Sew the longer strips to the sides of the quilt top. Sew a 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " black (SAFA 432 K) square to both ends of each shorter strip and then sew the strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

4. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired. Using the 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ "-wide strips, bind the edges to finish.
