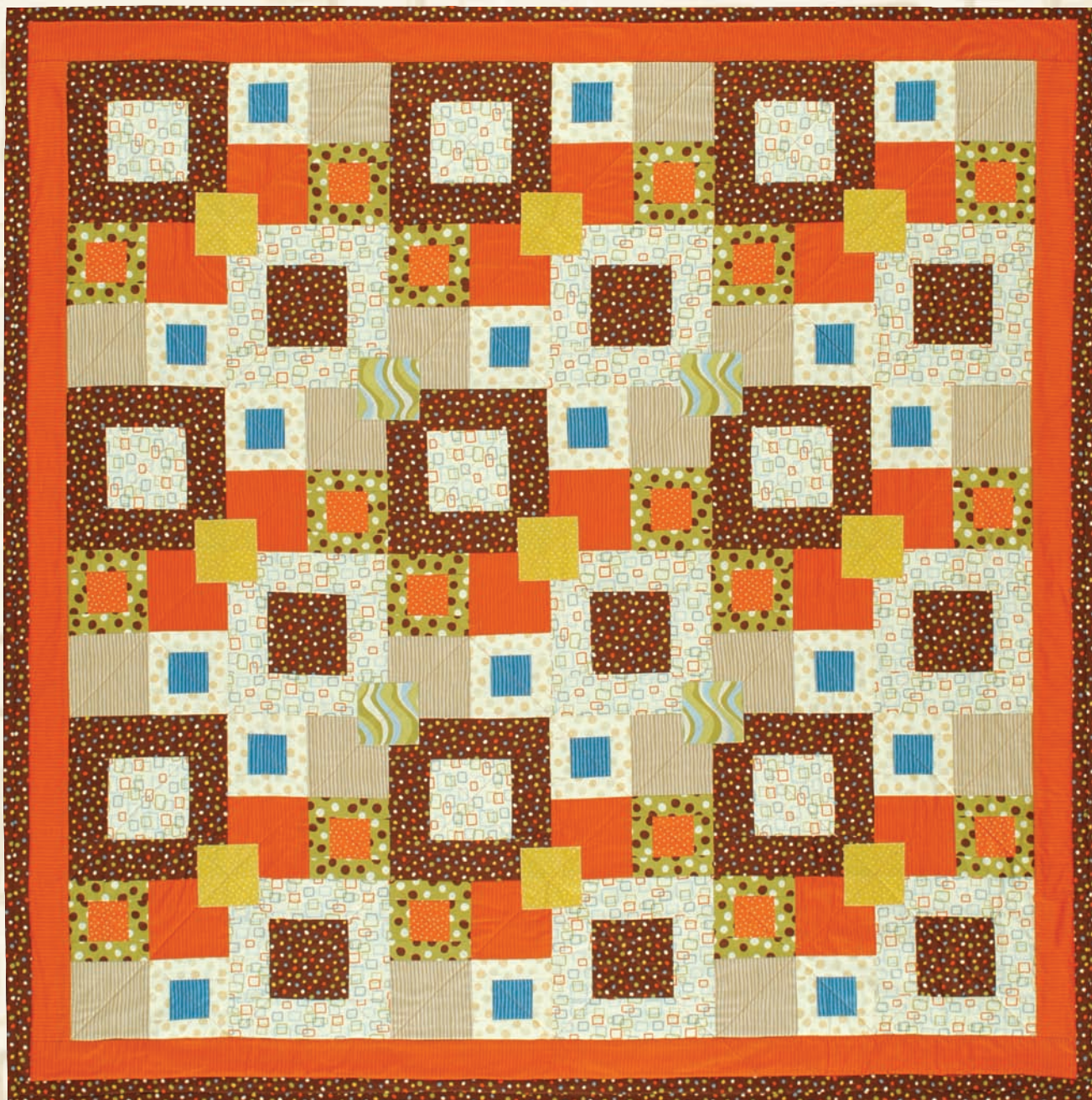

Cutting

All strips are cut across the width of fabric (wof).

White Squares, cut:

- (9) 4 1/2" squares
- (18) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips
- (18) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips

Brown Medium Dot, cut:

- (9) 4 1/2" squares.
- (18) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips
- (18) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips
- (6) 1 1/2" x wof outer border strips
- (6) 2 1/2" x wof binding strips

Blue Pinstripe, cut:

- (18) 2 1/2" squares

Yellow Large Dot, cut:

- (36) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips
- (36) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips

Red Mini Dot, cut:

- (18) 2 1/2" squares

Lime Large Dot, cut:

- (36) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips
- (36) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" strips

Tan Pinstripe, cut:

- (18) 4 1/2" squares

Red Pinstripe:

- (18) 4 1/2" squares
- (6) 2 1/2" x wof inner border strips

Yellow Mini Dot, cut:

- (9) 3" squares prepared with fusible web (see step 9)

Lime Wave, cut:

- (4) 3" squares prepared with fusible web (see step 10)

Assembly Instructions

1. Sew $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Brown Medium Dot strips to opposite sides of a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " White Squares square.
2. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Brown Medium Dot strip to each remaining side of the square to make an $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Brown Medium Dot Block.
3. Repeat to make a total of (9) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Brown Medium Dot Blocks.
4. Sew $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " White Squares strips to opposite sides of a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Brown Medium Dot square. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " White Squares strip to each remaining side of the square to make an $8\frac{1}{2}$ " White Squares Block. Repeat to make a total of (9) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " White Squares blocks.
5. Sew $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Yellow Large Dot strips to opposite sides of a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Blue Pinstripe square. Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Yellow Large Dot strip to each remaining side of the square to make a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Yellow Large Dot block. Repeat to make a total of (18) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Yellow Large Dot blocks.
6. Sew $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Lime Large Dot strips to opposite sides of a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Red Mini Dot square. Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Lime Large Dot strip to each remaining side of the square to make a $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Lime Large Dot block. Repeat to make a total of (18) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Lime Large Dot blocks.
7. To make an $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Four Patch block, lay out one Yellow Dot block, one Lime Large Dot block, one Red Pinstripe square, and one Tan Pinstripe square in a four-patch arrangement as shown in the photo. Sew the pieces together into rows and then sew the rows together. Make a total of (18) Four Patch blocks.
8. Refer to the photo for placement guidance and lay out the Brown Medium Dot blocks, the White Squares blocks, and the Four Patch blocks in six rows of six blocks each, alternating the blocks in each row and from row to row. Sew the blocks together into rows and then sew the rows together to make a $48\frac{1}{2}$ " square quilt top.
9. Following the manufacturer's instructions, press fusible web to the wrong side of the Yellow Mini Dot fabric. Cut nine 3" squares from the fusible-backed fabric.
10. In the same manner, press fusible web to the wrong side of Lime Wave fabric and cut four $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
11. Referring to the photo, press the Yellow Mini Dot squares and the Lime Wave squares to the quilt top as shown. Finish the raw edges of each square with matching thread and a decorative stitch such as a satin or buttonhole stitch.
12. Sew the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " wide Red Pinstripe strips together end to end. Cut two $48\frac{1}{2}$ " long strips and two $52\frac{1}{2}$ " long strips. Sew a shorter strip to each side and then sew a longer strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
13. Sew the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " wide Brown Medium Dot strips together end to end. Cut two $52\frac{1}{2}$ " long strips and two $54\frac{1}{2}$ " long strips. Sew a shorter strip to each side and then sew a longer strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
14. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
