

# SUMMER GARDEN

Quilt design by Lauren Neilly

Using **Summer Etchings** by Susie Robbins for P&B Textiles  
Finished Quilt: 52 1/2" squares -- Finished Block: 6"



### **Materials (based on 42"-wide fabric)**

3/4 yard	SETC 716P	Pink monochromatic flowers (block)
1/2 yard	SETC 718O	Orange background with small red flowers (block)
3/8 yard	SETC 715YO	Yellow background with medium flowers (block)
5/8 yard	SETC 717YO	Yellow plaid (sashing)
1/4 yard	SETC 718P	Pink background with small red flowers (sashing squares)
1/2 yard	SETC 719O	Orange background w/red outlined flowers (inner border)
1 1/8 yard	SETC 715F	Red floral (outer border)
2/3 yard	SETC 716O	Orange monochromatic flowers (binding)
3 1/4 yards	Any <i>Summer Etchings</i> fabric for backing	
56" x 56"	Piece of batting	

### **Cutting** - All strips are cut across the width of the fabric unless indicated otherwise

#### Block:

From SETC 716P-monochromatic pink: Cut (3) 3 1/2" strips and (6) 2" strips  
From SETC 718O-orange background with small red flowers: Cut (6) 2" strips  
From SETC 715YO-yellow background with medium flowers: Cut (3) 3-1/2" strips

#### Sashing Strips and Squares:

From SETC 717YO-yellow plaid: Cut (10) 2" strips; crosscut into (60) 2" x 6 1/2" strips  
From SETC 718P-pink background with small red flowers: Cut (2) 2" strips; crosscut into (36) 2" squares

#### Borders:

From SETC 719O-orange background with red outlined flowers: Cut (6) 2" strip  
From SETC 715F-red floral: Cut (6) 5 1/2" strips

#### Binding:

From SETC 716O-orange monochromatic flowers: Cut (6) 3 1/4" strips

### **Assembly**

1. Sew 2"-wide strips of 718O to both long sides of each 3 1/2"-wide strip of 716P to make a strip set; press. Make (3) strip sets. Cut the strip sets into (50) 2"-wide segments.
2. Sew 2"-wide strips of 716P to both long sides of each 3 1/2"-wide strip of 715YO to make a strip set; press. Make (3) strip sets. Cut the strip sets into (25) 3 1/2"-wide segments.
3. For each block, sew a segment from step 1 to both sides of each segment from step 2, as shown in the photo. Press the seam allowances toward the center. Make a total of (25) blocks.

4. Referring to the photo, arrange the blocks and plaid sashing strips on a design wall, aligning the plaid as best as you can in the horizontal and vertical sashing rows.
5. Sew (6) squares of 718P and (5) plaid sashing strips together to make a sashing row. Press the seam allowances toward the plaid strips. Make (6) sashing rows.
6. Sew (6) plaid sashing strips and (5) blocks together to make a block row. Press the seam allowances toward the plaid strips. Make (5) block rows.
7. Sew the sashing rows and block rows together, alternating them as shown in the photo. Press the seam allowances toward the sashing rows.
8. Sew the 2"-wide strips of 719O together end to end to make one long strip. Cut this long strip into four equal lengths. Sew the 5 1/2"-wide strips of 715F together end to end to make a long strip and cut into four equal lengths. Sew an orange strip and a red floral strip together along one long side to make a strip set. Make (4) strip sets.
9. Center and pin a border strip from step 8 to the top and bottom edges of the quilt top. Sew the strips from seam point to seam point and backstitch at the beginning and end of the seam. Add the border strips to the sides of the quilt in the same manner. Press the seams toward the outer border. Finish the corners with mitered seams. Press these seams open
10. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing; baste. Quilt as desired. Bind the edges to finish. Add a label to the back of your quilt and enjoy.
