

Old Blooms–Wallhanging

Using P&B's *Old Blooms* fabric collection by Pat Sloan.

Wallhanging size: 19" x 24"

Yardage

Backgrounds: ¼ yard each of 653E, 651E

Basket base: ¼ yard of 652N

Remaining appliqué fabrics: ⅛ yard each of 652R, 652C, 653G, 654G, 654C, 655X, 655R, 657Z

Inner Border: ⅛ yard of 657G

Outer border: ¼ yard of 653R

Cornerstones: ⅛ yard of 655N

Binding: ¼ yard of *Color Spectrum* 14R

Backing: ¾ yard of any *Old Blooms* fabric

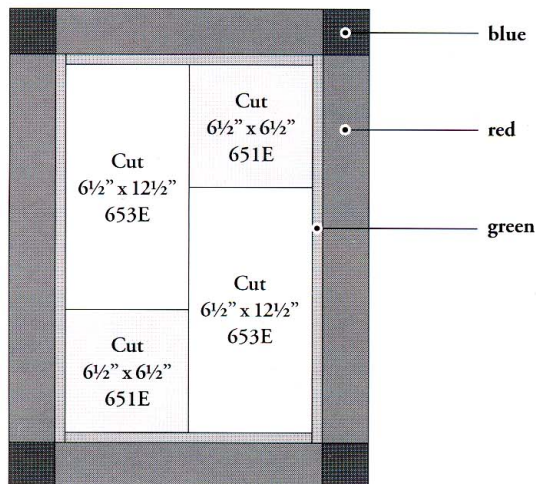
Cutting

Appliqué patterns are finished size. Wallhanging was made with fusible appliqué techniques. For background cut:

1. (4) ecru pieces following the diagram below
2. (2) green inner borders 12½" x 1¼"
3. (2) green inner borders 20" x 1¼"
4. (2) red outer borders 14" x 3"
5. (2) red outer borders 20" x 3"
6. (4) blue cornerstones 3" x 3"

Construction

1. Refer to diagram and photo to piece background pieces together. Press.
2. Add inner borders to top and bottom of wallhanging. Press toward borders. Repeat for side borders.
3. Add outer borders to top and bottom of wallhanging. Press toward borders. Add cornerstones to both ends of each side border. Press seams toward borders. Sew side borders to wallhanging and press.
4. Follow product instructions to use fusible web to adhere appliqué pieces to wallhanging.
5. Finish raw edges of all appliqué pieces with the machine stitch of your choice. Sample wallhanging used black thread and a narrow machine buttonhole stitch.
6. Layer, baste and quilt as desired. Sample wallhanging has free-form stitching in both the background and borders.
7. Prepare binding and sew to the wallhanging. *Don't forget your label!*

Old Blooms–Quilt

Quilt size: 77" x 101" using 16 blocks

Yardage

Backgrounds: 1⅞ yard each of 653E, 651E

Basket base: ½ yard of 652N

Remaining appliqué fabrics: ¼ yard each of 652R, 652C, 653G, 654G, 654C, 655X, 655R, 657Z

Block frames and outer border: 4¼ yards of 657G

Sashing: 1⅞ yard of 653R

Cornerstones and binding: 1 yard of 655N

Backing: 6 yards of any *Old Blooms* fabric (pieced vertically)

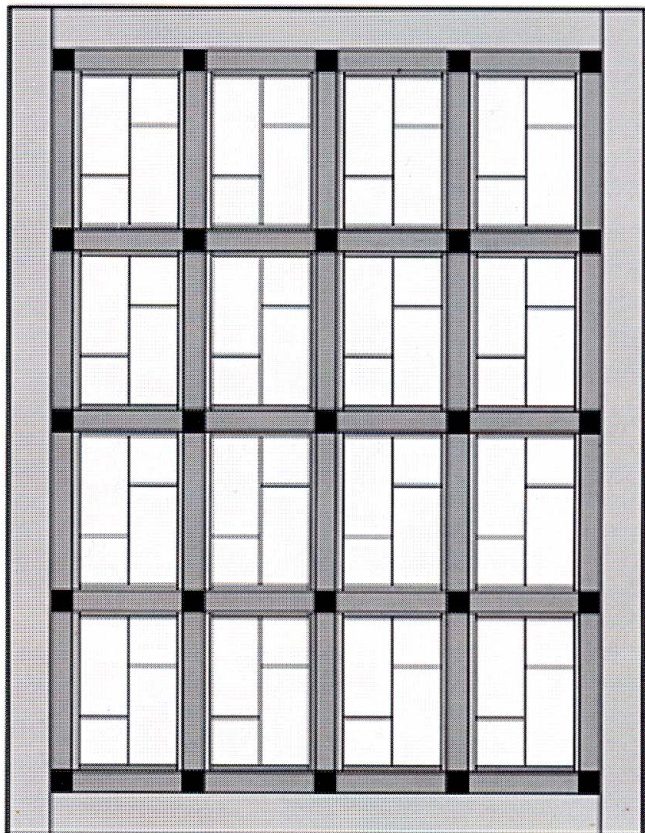
Note: if you desire additional backing width, you can use the remainder of outer border fabric.

Cutting

1. From each 651E and 653E: Cut (9) 6½" strips; crosscut into (16) 6½" x 6½" squares and (16) 6½" x 12½" rectangles.
2. From basket and remaining appliqué fabrics: Cut appropriate number as per pattern.
3. From 657G: Cut (14) 1¼" strips; crosscut into (32) 1¼" x 12½" rectangles and (32) 1¼" x 20" rectangles. From remaining fabric, cut (4) 5½" strips lengthwise (parallel to selvage); trim (2) 5½" x 67" and (2) 5½" x 101".
4. From 653R: Cut (17) 3" strips; crosscut into (20) 3" x 14" rectangles and (20) 3" x 20" rectangles.
5. From 655N: Cut (2) 3" strips; crosscut into (25) 3" x 3" squares.

Construction

Follow diagram and instructions from version 1 to construct 16 quilt blocks. Sew blocks together in 4 rows of 4 blocks each. Sew outer borders onto the center section.
