



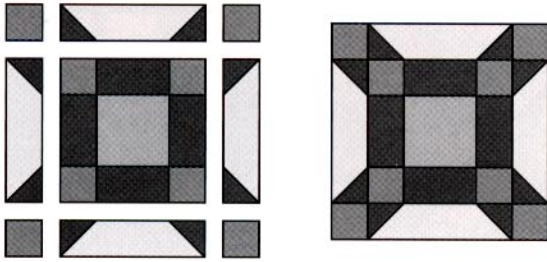


## Construction

For pieced blocks, mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " red squares. With right sides together, position on the ends of the  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " yellow rectangles and stitch on the drawn line. Trim seams to  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press open.



Sew the pieces together as shown in the diagram. Make a total of (4) blocks.



Prepare your appliqué pieces using your favorite method and appliqué onto the background squares by hand or by machine. Trim the blocks to 9" square. Sew the red print triangles to all sides of the appliqué blocks and press seams out. Make a total of (5) blocks.

Arrange blocks as shown in the photo, alternating appliqué and pieced blocks. Stitch together in rows, then stitch the rows together. Press seams.

Stitch the  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border strips to the sides and ends of the quilt top. Press seams toward the border. Repeat for the remaining two borders.

Piece the backing to measure 56" x 56". Layer, baste, and quilt as desired. Prepare the binding strips and sew to the quilt.
