

# Festive Stars Bed Quilt

## Yardage

2 1/2 yards of 786 B  
 2 3/8 yards of 790 B  
 1 3/8 yards of 787 Y  
 7/8 yard of 787 B  
 7/8 yard of 792 B  
 7/8 yard of 791 B  
 7/8 yard of 788 B  
 3/4 yard of 790 R  
 1/2 yard of 791 R  
 1/2 yard of 789 R  
 1/2 yard of 789 Y

Backing: 6 yards of your favorite  
*Sunflower Fiesta* fabric

## Cutting

### BLOCKS

**786 B** - from the length of the fabric (parallel to the selvedge) cut 2 strips, 5 1/2" x 82 1/2" and 2 strips, 5 1/2" x 76 1/2" (set these aside for the middle border), then cut 20 squares, 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

**787 Y** - cut 80 rectangles, 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" and 80 squares, 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

**791 B** - cut 160 squares, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

**790 R** - cut 80 squares, 2 7/8" x 2 7/8"

**789 Y** - cut 80 squares, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

**789 R** - cut 80 squares, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

**791 R** - cut 80 squares, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

**790 B** - cut 80 squares, 4 7/8" x 4 7/8", cut once diagonally to yield 160 triangles

**787 B** - cut 10 squares, 9 1/4" x 9 1/4", cut twice diagonally to yield 40 triangles

**792 B** - cut 10 squares, 9 1/4" x 9 1/4", cut twice diagonally to yield 40 triangles

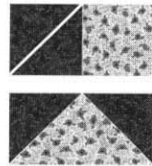
### BORDERS AND BINDING

**790 B** - cut 8 strips, 1 1/2" x 42" (inner border) and 9 strips, 2" x 42" (binding)

**788 B** - cut 10 strips, 2 1/2" x 42" (outer border)

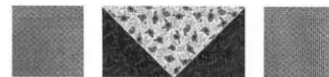
## Directions

**1.** Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each blue (791 B) 2 1/2" square. Place a blue square on one end of each 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle. Stitch on the marked line. Trim away the excess fabric and press. Place a blue square on the other end of the rectangle. Sew on the line; trim, and press. Make 80 units.

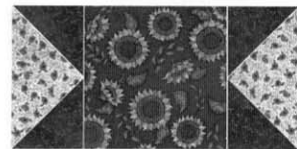


step 1

**2.** Sew four units from step 1, four yellow-check (789 Y) squares, and one sunflower (786 B) square together to make a star block. Make 20.

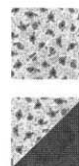


**3.** Layer the 2 7/8" yellow (787 Y) and red (790 R) squares in pairs, with right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the yellow square. Stitch 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to yield two half-square triangles and press. Make 160 half-square triangle units.



step 2

**4.** Sew two units from step 3, one red-check (789 R) square, and one red (791 R) square together to make a four patch unit. Make 80.

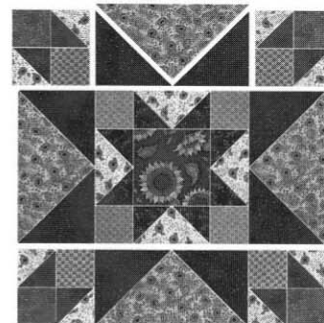


step 3

**5.** Sew two blue (790 B) 4 7/8" triangles, and one blue (787 B) 9 1/4" triangle together to make a unit. Make 40.

**6.** Sew two blue (790 B) 4 7/8" triangles, and one blue (792 B) 9 1/4" triangle together to make a unit. Make 40.

**7.** Sew one block from step 2, four units from step 4, and four units from step 5 together to make one block. Make 10 and label as block A.



step 7

**8.** Sew one block from step 2, four units from step 4, and four units from step 6 together to make one block. Make 10 and label as block B.

**9.** Arrange and sew the blocks into five rows of four blocks each, alternating blocks A and B as shown on the cover; press. Sew the rows together; press.

**10.** Sew the navy inner-border strips together end to end. Press and cut two 80 1/2" strips. Sew a strip to each of the side edges; press. Cut two 66 1/2" strips and sew to the top and bottom edges; press.

**11.** Sew an 82 1/2" middle-border strip to each of the side edges. Sew a 76 1/2" border strip to the top and bottom edges. Press all seams toward the borders.

**12.** Sew the outer-border strips together end to end. Cut two 101" strips, for the side borders and two 85" strips for the top and bottom borders. Center and sew a strip to each side of the quilt, starting and stopping 1/4" from each corner. Finish the corners with mitered seams. Press.

**13.** Layer the quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind the edges to finish. *Don't forget your label!*

<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yard of 788 G

<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yard of 791 R

<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yard of 792 Z

<sup>3</sup>/<sub>8</sub> yard of 787 Y

Backing: 4 yards of your favorite  
*Sunflower Fiesta* fabric

## Cutting

### BLOCKS

**786 G** - from the length of the fabric (parallel to the selvedge) cut 2 strips, 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 50 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" and 2 strips, 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 58 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" (set these aside for the middle border), then cut 9 squares, 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"

**792 E** - cut 36 rectangles, 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" and 36 squares, 2 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 2 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"

**790 Z** - cut 36 squares, 4 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 4 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>", cut once diagonally to yield 72 triangles; and cut 72 squares 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"

**791 R** - cut 36 squares, 2 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 2 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>"

**789 G** - cut 72 squares, 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"

**787 Y** - cut 36 squares, 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"

**791 G** - cut 5 squares, 9 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 9 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>", cut twice diagonally to yield 20 triangles

**792 Z** - cut 4 squares, 9 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 9 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>", cut twice diagonally to yield 16 triangles

### BORDERS AND BINDING

**790 Z** - cut 5 strips, 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 42" (inner border) and 7 strips, 2" x 42" (binding)

**788 G** - cut 7 strips, 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 42" (outer border)

## Directions

*Note: Refer to the bed quilt for complete sewing instructions.*

1. Sew two brown (790 Z) squares and one beige (792 E) rectangle together to make a unit. Make 36.
2. Sew four units from step 1, four green-check (789 G) squares, and one sunflower (786 G) square together to make a star block. Make 9.
3. Layer, mark and sew the beige and red (791 R) squares together in pairs. Cut and press to make 72 half-square triangle units.
4. Sew two units from step 3, one green-check square, and one yellow (787 Y) square together to make a four-patch unit. Make 36.
5. Sew two brown (790 Z) triangles and one green (791 G) triangle together to make a unit. Make 20.
6. Sew two brown triangles and one tan (792 Z) triangle together to make a unit. Make 16.
7. Sew one block from step 2, four units from step 4, and four units from step 5 together to make a block. Make 5 and label as block A.
8. Sew one block from step 2, four units from step 4, and four units from step 6 together to make a block. Make 4 and label as block B.
9. Arrange and sew the blocks into three rows of three blocks each, alternating blocks A and B as shown; press. Sew the rows together.
10. Sew the inner-border strips together end to end. Cut two 48 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips and sew to the side edges. Cut two 50 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips, and sew to the top and bottom edges.
11. Sew the 50 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" middle-border strips to the side edges. Sew the 58 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips to the top and bottom edges.
12. Sew the outer-border strips end to end and cut four 70" strips. Center and sew a strip to each side of the quilt, starting and stopping <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" from each corner. Finish the corners with mitered seams.
