In 1994 Linda co-founded Brandywine Design, a publisher of patterns and books for the quilting industry.

Brandywine Design has published over 60 patterns and fifteen books with her original quilt designs and illustrations. She began designing fabric for P&B Textiles in 2004.

Linda has two grown children and lives with her husband in a rural suburb of Minneapolis where she works from her home studio, overlooking a horse pasture and century-old oak trees. The natural surrounding are a constant source of inspiration.
