Backing

4 yards of your favorite *Sweet Pea* fabric

Cutting

Blocks and outer border

476 P - cut 48 rectangles, 2¹/₂" x 4¹/₂"

472 K - cut 96 squares, 2¹/₂" x 2¹/₂"

473 E - cut 48 squares, 4¹/₂" x 4¹/₂"

476 F - cut 48 squares, 2¹/₂" x 2¹/₂"

472 F - cut 48 squares, 2¹/₂" x 2¹/₂"

474 P - cut 48 rectangles, 2¹/₂" x 4¹/₂"

471 K - from the lengthwise grain, cut 2 strips, 5¹/₂" x 67¹/₂" and 2 strips, 5¹/₂" x 62¹/₂" (set these aside for the outer border) and 12 squares, 4¹/₂" x 4¹/₂"

Sashing and pieced border

475 P - cut 22 strips, 1¹/₂" x 42"; 14 rectangles, 2¹/₂" x 12¹/₂"; 18 rectangles 2¹/₂" x 3¹/₂"; and 2 squares, 2⁷/₈" x 2⁷/₈"

476 K - cut 11 strips, 1¹/₂" x 42"

472 F - cut 20 squares, 3¹/₂" x 3¹/₂"; 28 squares, 2¹/₂" x 2¹/₂"; and 2 squares, 2⁷/₈" x 2⁷/₈"

Binding

476 K - cut 8 strips, 2" x 42"

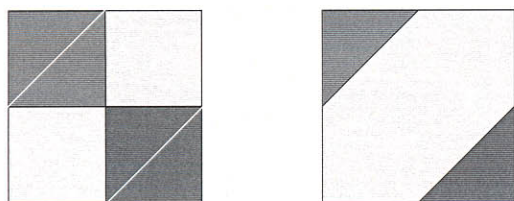


Directions

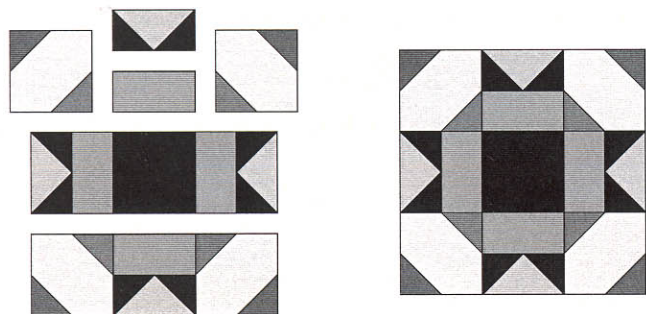
- 1 Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each black (472 K) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Place a marked square on one end of each $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " pink (476 P) rectangle. Stitch on the marked line. Trim away the excess fabric and press. Place a square on the other end of the rectangle. Sew on the drawn line; trim the excess fabric, and press. Make 48.



- 2 Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each red (472 F) and dark pink (476 F) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Place a red square and a dark pink square on opposite corners of each $4\frac{1}{2}$ " floral (473 E) square. Stitch on the marked line. Trim away the excess fabric and press. Make 48.



- 3 Sew four units from step 1, four units from step 2, four pink (474 P) rectangles and one black (471 K) square together, as shown, to make one block. Make 12 blocks.

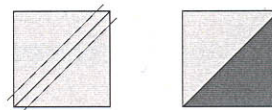


- 4 Sew two pink (475 P) and one black (476 K) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips together to make a strip set. Make 11 strips sets. Cut the strips sets into 31 segments, $12\frac{1}{2}$ " wide.

- 5 Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each red (472 F) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Place a marked square on opposite ends of each $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " pink (475 P) rectangle. Stitch on the marked lines, as shown. Trim away the excess fabric and press. Make 14.



- 6 Layer the $2\frac{7}{8}$ " pink (475 P) squares and red (472 F) squares in pairs, with right sides together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the pink square. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to yield two half-square triangles and press. Make 4.



- 7 Sew two pink (475 P) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, three sashing units from step 4, and four red (472 F) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares together to make a sashing row. Press and make five rows.

Directions continued

8 Sew three blocks, four sashing units from step 4 and 2 units from step 5 together to make a block row. Press and make four rows.

9 Arrange and sew the sashing rows and block rows together, as shown, and press.

10 Sew three units from step 5, four pink (475 P) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 3\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles, and two units from step 6 together to make a border row. Sew to the top and bottom edges; press.

11 Sew a $67\frac{1}{2}''$ outer border strip to each of the side edges; press. Sew a $62\frac{1}{2}''$ outer border strip to the top and bottom edges; press.

12 Layer the quilt top with batting and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind the edges to finish.
