

Village Sampler Wallhanging

Using P&B's *Welcome Home* fabric collection

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Wallhanging size: 30" x 42½"

Please read the instructions from start to finish before doing any cutting or sewing. Measurements given with the cutting instructions include a ¼" seam allowance. Precision in both cutting and sewing is very important. Applique templates are given in actual size without a seam allowance. If you are making the quilt using fusible appliqué, trace the shapes as given and follow the manufacturer's instructions for fusing. If you want to do hand appliqué using the needle turn method, trace the shapes onto the right side of the appropriate fabric, leaving enough space around each traced shape to cut approximately ⅜" outside the traced line for seam allowance. Fold the seam allowance under to the traced line as you stitch. When tracing directional shapes that are opposite each other, be sure to trace one facing one direction and the second facing opposite. Pay close attention to any appliqué sections that overlay each other and be sure to apply them in the proper order. Use the photo and the cutting instructions as a guide for the fabric placements. Sew the background sections together before adding the appliqué.

Yardage

Red leaf for sashing, binding, rooster comb, wattle, and body, berries and log cabin centers: ¾ yard of 465R

Village print for village strips and vine background: 1 yard of 460N

Green texture for the inner border, rooster head, vines and leaves ¼ yard of 466G

Blue curl for Log Cabin logs: ⅛ yard of 464N

Blue berry for Log Cabin logs: ⅛ yard of 462N

Blue texture for star and moon background, corner blocks, Log Cabin logs and heart: ¼ yard of 466B

Floral print for the outer border: ½ yard of 461N

Gold curl for the D star, moon and Log Cabin logs: ½ yard of 464X

Gold leaf for Log Cabin logs: ⅛ yard of 465X

Gold heart for the sun, stars A, B, C, rooster beaks, wings and legs, Log Cabin logs: ⅛ yard of 463X

Beige texture for the sun and rooster background: ⅛ yard of 466W

Backing: 1¼ yards of any *Welcome Home* fabric

Cutting

1. Sun/Rooster Strip

- 466W Cut (1) 5" x 18½" rectangle
- 465R Cut (2) rooster combs, (2) wattles, (2) bodies (cut one of these reversed)
- 466G Cut (2) rooster heads (cut one of these reversed)
- 463X Cut (2) rooster beaks, (2) wings, (1) sun, (2) legs (cut one wing and one leg reversed)

2. Village Strip

- 460N Cut (2) 4¼" x 18½" rectangles (center the village design). Note: Cut the village strips with a ¼" seam allowance on each side of the village. The heart border will not be visible after sewing, as it will be sewn into the seam allowance.

3. Vine Strip

- 460N Cut (1) 5" x 18½" bias rectangle

Note: Cut the checked background rectangle on the bias so the checks are running on the diagonal. Give special care when sewing the bias cut edge since it will be unstable and will have a tendency to stretch.

- 465R Cut (6) berries
- 466G Cut (6) leaves; cut (2) vines (cut one reversed)
- 466B Cut (1) heart

4. Stars and Moon Strip

- 466B Cut (1) 5" x 18½" rectangle
- 464X Cut (1) star D, (1) moon
- 463X Cut (1 each) of stars A, B, C

5. Log Cabins (4 blocks)

- 465R Cut (1) 2" strip; subcut into (4) 2" squares
Note: Use the remainder of the strip to cut a sashing strip referred to in step 6.
- 464N Cut (1) 1" strip; subcut into (4) 1" x 2" logs, position 1, and (4) 1" x 2½" logs, position 2
- 464X Cut (1) 1" strip; subcut into (4) 1" x 2½" logs, position 3, and (4) 1" x 3" logs, position 4
- 462N Cut (1) 1" strip; subcut into (4) 1" x 3" logs, position 5, and (4) 1" x 3½" logs, position 6
- 465X Cut (1) 1" strip; subcut into (4) 1" x 3½" logs, position 7, and (4) 1" x 4" logs, position 8
- 466B Cut (1) 1" strip; subcut into (4) 1" x 4" logs, position 9, and (4) 1" x 4½" logs, position 10
- 463X Cut (1) 1" strip; subcut into (4) 1" x 4½" logs, position 11, and (4) 1" x 5" logs, position 12

6. Sashing Strips

- 465R Cut (5) 1½" strips. Trim (2) to 33" strips. Trim the remaining strips into (6) 18½" strips. Use the remainder of the Log Cabin centers 2" strip and cut it to 1½" x 18½".

7. Inner Border

- 466G Cut (3) 2" strips. Trim one into (2) 20½" strips. Trim (2) into 33" strips.
- 466B Cut (4) 2" squares, for corner blocks.

8. Outer Border

- 461N Cut (4) 4" strips. Trim (2) into 23½" strips. Trim (2) into 36" strips.
- 466B Cut (4) 4" squares, for corner blocks.

9. Binding

- 465R Cut (4) 2" strips

Construction

Use assembly diagrams as a guide for sewing the quilt sections together. Sew background and sashing strips together. Add sashing along each side. Add green border strips to top and bottom. Sew 2" corner blocks to each end of the side border strips and sew a border/corner block unit to each side. Repeat with the floral outer border and 4" corner blocks. See Diagram A.

Making the Log Cabin Blocks: Follow the assembly diagram to assemble the Log Cabin blocks. Begin with the center square and add logs consecutively around the center. When the 4 blocks are completed, sew them together in a strip. Use the photo as a guide for placement of each block. See Diagram B.

Finishing: Layer the quilt back right side down, batting and quilt top right side up, baste and quilt as desired. Prepare the binding using the 2" red strips and apply as desired. Date and sign your quilt.
